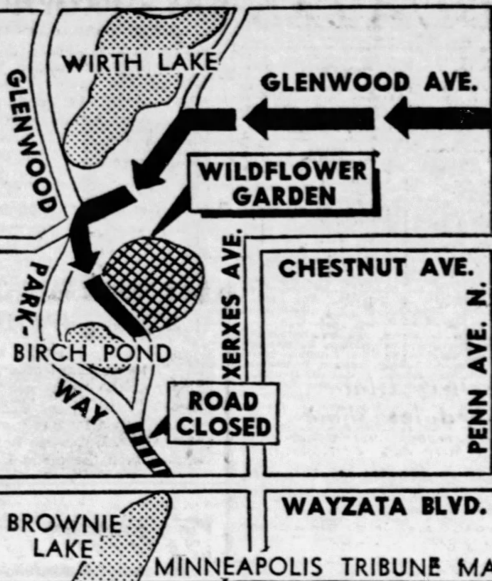


# OLSON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY



**ROUTE TO WILDFLOWER GARDEN** — Minneapolis park officials pointed out Saturday that it is no longer possible to reach the Eloise Butler wildflower garden in Theodore Wirth park by way of Wayzata boulevard. The map shows how to drive to the garden from the Minneapolis loop by going out Glenwood avenue and turning left on Glenwood parkway. Construction of the approach for a new Wayzata boulevard bridge makes it impossible to turn off the boulevard onto Glenwood parkway. Mrs. Martha Crone, curator, reported that visits to the garden have been reduced because many people have been unable to find it. A number of flowers are in bloom now, she said.
